My name is Allan Brunson. I represent RAD Enterprises, LLC. We operate a cattle ranch in Torrance County north of Corona, New Mexico. Our ranch is in the route planned for the Sun Zia Transmission Project, and we will be impacted by the construction and operation of this Project.

We are very much in favor of this project and see it as an opportunity to help our operation financially and to support the development of the wind farm planned for our area. We don't believe the transmission line will hinder our operation at all and will facilitate the installation of wind turbines on our property and our neighbors as well.

Given the need for renewable energy development in our country to meet the aggressive goals set by our leaders this project and many others must be implemented and we look forward to being involved.

According to the maps of this adjusted route that will cross our property, we support the combination of the following routes: Segment 4- Route 1, Route 3, Sub-route A-1 and Sub-route B-2, along with original par alignment Segments 1-3. Also it seems wise and efficient to rebuild the existing transmission through the Sevilleta NWR, not disturbing more ROW property through that area.
